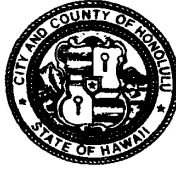

Dear Homeowners and Residents:

PROJECT NAME: Kuahea Street Interim Improvements
Waiomao Road to 2373 Kuahea Street
Resurface Kuahea Place and Helo Place
Job No. 03-15

As you may know, the Kuahea Street Interim Improvements Project has been significantly delayed, as the City's contractor for this work abruptly went out of business and defaulted on the contract in 2017, and a new contractor had to be engaged to complete the project.


Additionally, after reassessing the status of the area and the City's approach to address the natural earth movement in this area, the scope of the contract has been revised as follows:

- Updating the existing drainage system along Waiomao Road from Kuahea Street to 10th Avenue has been completed, as originally planned.
- The asphalt pavement on Kuahea Street from Kuahea Place to 2373 Kuahea Street will be resurfaced, as originally planned.
- The asphalt pavement on Helo Street will be resurfaced, as originally planned.
- The asphalt pavement on Kuahea Place will not be resurfaced under the contract. Instead, Kuahea Place asphalt pavement will be maintained by the City's Department of Facility Maintenance.
- The concrete pavement on Kuahea Street will not be reconstructed, and that work has been removed from the contract.
- The portion of Kuahea Street between Kuahea Place and 2319 Kuahea Street will be temporarily closed. The City intends to permanently close this section of Kuahea Street and regrade this area to reduce earth movement and impacts to the City's infrastructure.

All residents will have access to their properties, but some residents may be required to access their properties from the upper Kuahea Street-Waiomao Road intersection. Please see the enclosed map.
